IMPLEMENT SOCIAL PROTECTION SYSTEMS

Implement nationally appropriate social protection systems and measures for all, including floors, and by 2030 achieve substantial coverage of the poor and the vulnerable.

EQUAL RIGHTS TO OWNERSHIP, BASIC SERVICES, TECHNOLOGY AND ECONOMIC RESOURCES

By 2030, ensure that all men and women, in particular the poor and the vulnerable, have equal rights to economic resources, as well as access to basic services, ownership and control over land and other forms of property, inheritance, natural resources, appropriate new technology and financial services, including microfinance.

BUILD RESILIENCE TO ENVIRONMENTAL, ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL DISASTERS

By 2030, build the resilience of the poor and those in vulnerable situations and reduce their exposure and vulnerability to climate-related extreme events and other economic, social and environmental shocks and disasters.

END ALL FORMS OF MALNUTRITION

By 2030, end all forms of malnutrition, including achieving, by 2025, the internationally agreed targets on stunting and wasting in children under 5 years of age, and address the nutritional needs of adolescent girls, pregnant and lactating women and older persons.

DOUBLE THE PRODUCTIVITY AND INCOMES OF SMALL-SCALE FOOD PRODUCERS

By 2030, double the agricultural productivity and incomes of small-scale food producers, in particular women, indigenous peoples, family farmers, pastoralists and fishers, including through secure and equal access to land, other productive resources and inputs, knowledge, financial services, markets and opportunities for value addition and non-farm employment.

SUSTAINABLE FOOD PRODUCTION AND RESILIENT AGRICULTURAL PRACTICES

By 2030, ensure sustainable food production systems and implement resilient agricultural practices that increase productivity and production, that help maintain ecosystems, that strengthen capacity for adaptation to climate change, extreme weather, drought, flooding and other disasters and that progressively improve land and soil quality.

MAINTAIN THE GENETIC DIVERSITY IN FOOD PRODUCTION

By 2020, maintain the genetic diversity of seeds, cultivated plants and farmed and domesticated animals and their related wild species, including through soundly managed and diversified seed and plant banks at the national, regional and international levels, and promote access to and fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising from the utilization of genetic resources and associated traditional knowledge, as internationally agreed.

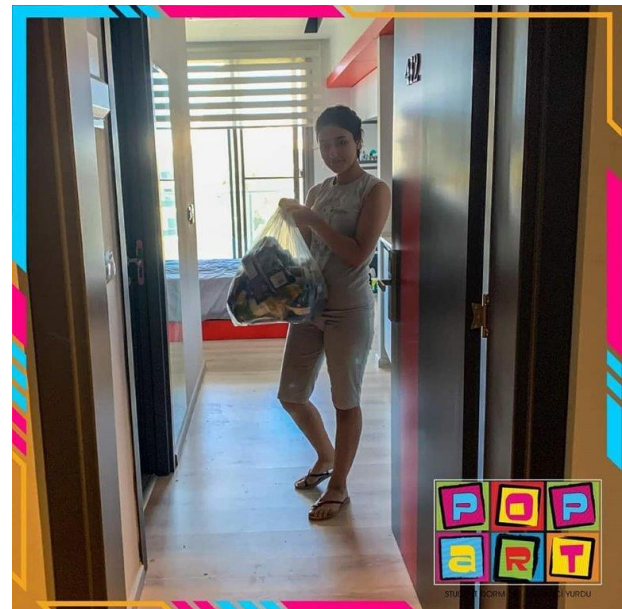
Increase investment, including through enhanced international cooperation, in rural infrastructure, agricultural research and extension services, technology development and plant and livestock gene banks in order to enhance agricultural productive capacity in developing countries, in particular least developed countries.

PREVENT AGRICULTURAL TRADE RESTRICTIONS, MARKET DISTORTIONS AND EXPORT SUBSIDIES

Correct and prevent trade restrictions and distortions in world agricultural markets, including through the parallel elimination of all forms of agricultural export subsidies and all export measures with equivalent effect, in accordance with the mandate of the Doha Development Round.

ENSURE STABLE FOOD COMMODITY MARKETS AND TIMELY ACCESS TO INFORMATION

Adopt measures to ensure the proper functioning of food commodity markets and their derivatives and facilitate timely access to market information, including on food reserves, in order to help limit extreme food price volatility.

By 2030, end the epidemics of AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria and neglected tropical diseases and combat hepatitis, water-borne diseases and other communicable diseases.

By 2030, substantially reduce the number of deaths and illnesses from hazardous chemicals and air, water and soil pollution and contamination.

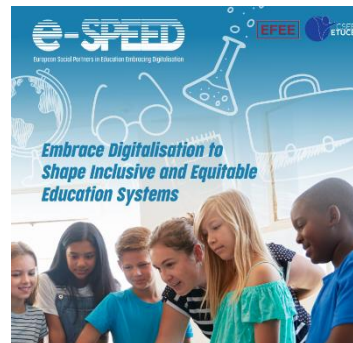

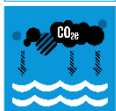

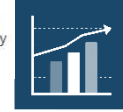

Trade union engagement and activity in Europe: mobilising for quality public education, for the benefit of students, and an improved status for teachers and all education personnel

Eastern Mediterranean University Union of Academic Staff (DAÜ-SEN), Cyprus

Foundation of the Trade Union in 1984

Our union was established in 1984 as the High Technology Institute Employees' Union, as an organization covering all the employees of the High Technology Institute (YTE) in order to protect the rights of the employees.

A group of 20-40 people played an active role in the establishment works. A group of employees working at YTE, a certain segment with high social awareness who came to the island from post-1960 Turkey, believing in organized struggle and a conscious segment from the island came together and started the struggle.

Changing the Name of the Trade Union in 1987

With the establishment of Eastern Mediterranean University in 1989, the name of the union was changed to Eastern Mediterranean University Employees' Union at the General Assembly held in February 1987.

Separation of the Academic Staff in 1982

As a result of the opinion that the unions of the Worker and Administrative Staff should be separate and that the problems of the academic staff were different, it was decided to continue the organized struggle as an academic staff union with a majority of votes at the General Assembly meeting held in February 1982. The name of the union was changed to Eastern Mediterranean University Academic Staff Union (DAÜ-SEN).

Significant Growth of DAÜ-SEN in 2004

2004 and the following years were a period of significant growth for DAÜ-SEN. While it was a union with few members until those years, where left-wing people came together and struggled intensely, the union administrators of the period made an opening with the idea that the union was a labor union and that academics from all kinds of views meeting this common principle should meet at DAÜ-SEN. This initiative received a response from the academics working at the university and the number of members increased fourfold in that period and reached 700.

First Collective Agreement in 2005

With its rapidly growing new member structure, DAÜ-SEN passed one of its biggest challenges at the end of 2005. As a result of the disagreement with the university administration, a day strike was held. As a result of this serious struggle, a Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) was signed for the first time between DAÜ-SEN and the university administration. With the signing of the first CBA:

- transparent management;
- performance-based job security;
- permanent personal status;
- election of administrators;
- and representation as an observer in the University Administrative Board and University Senate were gained.

Main Principles of DAÜ-SEN

DAÜ-SEN, which has a modern and democratic charter, works according to the principles of democracy contained in its internal functioning. It is independent of the government, political parties, organizations and formations in its organizational functioning and decision-making processes. It rejects all kinds of intervention and control in this direction. The union aims to ensure the unity and integrity of all its members, regardless of language, religion, race, color, gender, sexual orientation, political thought, philosophical belief, or sect. It encourages women members to take part in union activities and management more effectively.

International Member Profile of DAÜ-SEN

DAÜ-SEN, which is against all kinds of oppression, including Turkish Cypriot institutionalization, is the only union in Cyprus with members from different religions, languages, nationalities and cultures and with an international member profile. For many years, the union mainly included foreign faculty members in its management, management more effectively.

Adequate Protection of the Members and their Dependents

It strives to ensure that its members and their dependents can benefit from adequate protection and care measures, basic economic, social and legal rights, in cases of retirement, old age, disability, disability, orphanhood, to improve care, education and health conditions.













Social Unionism and DAÜ-SEN

The two collective agreements signed in the last four years are the important examples of these achievements. At the same time, as a strong member of the Trade Union Platform, DAÜ-SEN always acts in collaboration and solidarity with other sister trade unions.			

New Goals & New Project

Leading Quality in Higher Education by a Public University

ETMU is the only public university unit there is a threat for privatization so DAÜ-SEN is struggling to keep it as a public university. There is no collapse on the solution of problems in higher education with the Higher Education Planning, Accreditation and Coordination Council (YÖKAK) and the Ministry of Education. It is obvious that we, as DAÜ-SEN, need to be more persistent to achieve and realize in this dialogue.

Working for SDG's and Environmental Sustainability

Working to achieve Sustainable Development Goals (SDG's) has become one of a new goal by DAÜ-SEN general assembly.



The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, adopted by all United Nations Member States in 2015, provides a shared blueprint for peace and prosperity for people and the planet, now and into the future. At its heart are the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which are an urgent call for action by all countries - developed and developing - in global partnership.




"Learning for Sustainability" Project

The main aims of building this project are "learning for sustainability", "healthy life and healthy food" and "leading for Sustainable Development Goals (SDG's)". There will be a center which will include study and research areas and also teaching for SDG's. In a corner there will be a Library, Café and also a restaurant where the members will have chance to have healthy foods. - **Leading Quality in Higher Education by a Public University**

EMU is the only state university and there is a threat for its privatization, so DAÜ-SEN is struggling to keep it as a public university. There is no dialogue on the solution of problems in higher education with the Higher Education Planning, Accreditation and Coordination Council (YÖDAK) and the Ministry of Education. It is obvious that we, as DAÜ-SEN, need to be more persistent to achieve and maintain this dialogue.

The main aims of building this project are "learning for sustainability", "healthy life and healthy food" and "teaching for Sustainable Development Goals (SDG's)".

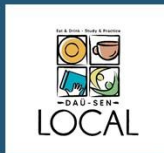
There will be a center which will include study and research areas and also teaching for SDG's. In this center there will be a Library Café and also a restaurant where the members will have chance to have healthy foods.
